Principal's Message


As I said last week, it is great to have everyone back at school. It is hard to believe that we are near the end of term, a term like no other we have ever experienced!

If you need to sign your late child in and they enter via Nicholson Street or McCulloch St entrance please **do not** walk them directly to their classroom, you should either have your child come to the office and **sign themselves** in or alternatively you can call the school from the gate and we will send a staff member out to collect your child.

If you need to pick your child up for an appointment or their program requires them to be picked up earlier then you must enter via Main Street and come directly to the office, we will then call the classroom and have your child sent over. Parent Teacher Phone Interviews:

This year we are having to change our normal onsite/face to face Parent/Teacher interviews into phone interviews. Teachers will call you from school at your pre-booked time and you will have the usual 15 minute appointment time slot. Parents will need to log into Compass to make an appointment, once logged you will see your child's profile picture and the link to make an appointment will be there. The booking system will be open to parents on Monday 15th June. Parent/ Teacher interviews will take place on Thursday 25th June from 3.30pm - 7.00pm and again on Friday 26th June from 8.30am - 1.00pm

If using your phone to make Parent Teacher interviews please use the Compass for Education App as going in through a browser app like Google Chrome or Safari will not work.



Please also be reminded that Friday 26th is a student free day and is also the start of school holidays. Term 3 commences on Monday 13th July.





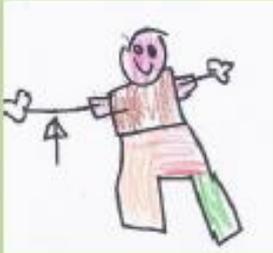
