Principal's Message

Week 9 Term 2

It is hard to believe that we are nearly at the end of Term 2. Student reports will be handed out to all students next week. Please ensure that you read the report and take the time to talk to your child about the progress that they have made. I hope that everyone has been noticing the changes that have been made to the schoolyard over the past few weeks. Some of these changes have been:

- The vegetable garden area has been cleaned up and a picket fence has been erected
- The boat in the sandpit has been removed
- The wooden poles along the fence line (Main St) have been removed
- Edging around the gardens at the front of the school have been removed and replaced

Future changes to the schoolyard:

- New synthetic surface on the Netball and Basketball to be laid
- The sandpit area where the boat used to be will be re-developed
- The two sandpits along McCulloch St will be removed and replaced with a new climbing frame
- The entrance area in between the office building, Prep Room and the 5/6 area will be redeveloped

We are hoping that the recent rain will not delay the scheduled works in Term 3.

Covid On-Site Rules:

Once again due to Covid-19 restrictions we must follow the Schools Operational Guidelines.

NO Parents/Carers are to enter the school grounds. You must **drop off** and **pick up** from the gates only.

If you need to sign your late child in and they enter via Nicholson Street or McCulloch St entrance please **do not** walk them directly to their classroom, you should either have your child come to the office and **sign themselves** in or alternatively you can call the school from the gate and we will send a staff member out to collect your child.

If you need to pick your child up for an appointment or their program requires them to be picked up earlier then you should enter via Main Street and come directly to the office, we will then call the classroom and have your child sent over. Please do not go directly to the classroom.

These new restrictions will be in place for the foreseeable future. Thank you all for your understanding.

- 5/6 C:** **Alec Cross** you have been persistent, worked hard and listened to feedback to up-level and publish a great information report.




