Speaking of Ken Jeanes, I am afraid that Ken will be away from the school now for a considerable length of time, whilst he is dealing with illness. Ken is currently in Melbourne and I don't believe that we will see him again this year – I will keep our community informed.

Hats: It seems odd to be talking about hats when today is overcast, cold and raining!



However, as part of DET's Sunsmart policy: All children are required to wear a broad brimmed hat during term's 1 and 4. Can you help support our work by ensuring that your child has a broad brimmed hat and understands that the expectation is that they wear it each day, when outside. Hats can be purchased at the uniform shop or Target / Kmart stores. Of course the cheaper alternative is to "find the one from term 1". Please put names on hats, as "one green hat is just like the next green

hat". Children who do not have hats will be encouraged into specific shaded areas in the school and the office will not be "loaning" hats. Thanks for your help.

We have been very lucky to have Dan Petro working with us again over the last 2 days. The focus of his work this time was around specific behaviours and the smartest and most effective ways to deal with what we are seeing to maximise outcomes. Dan also ran a parenting information session on Monday night. The numbers for this where smaller than earlier in the year, but this allowed more conversations and question time. Dan has worked with the school for just on 2 years now and has been a significant contributor to our continuous improvement.

Wednesday the 17th October, the leadership team will be withdrawing from the school for the day to meet and discuss all aspects of our work in 2018, given the data we have back, there will be a key focus on our AIP (Annual Implementation Plan) and also setting goals and directions for 2019.

During my time away, lots of events where arranged, so please be sure to be "all over" the following:

- 1. **Dental Day** This is occurring next Tuesday the 16th October. When the whole school will be in the hall for a presentation. 11.30am to 12.30pm. We will need to make some small adjustments to the days' timetable.
- 2. **Swimming Program** Every class from Preps to grade 4 will go swimming EVEY Monday for the rest of the term. Please be sure that your child has returned notes, has bathers, towel etc Each class will go at the same time every week. If you have any concerns, please say something quickly!
- 3. **Walk to School Day** Tuesday the 16th October is "Walk to School Day". The 754 group will meet Mr Fraser out the front of Kmart at 8.15am and walk as a group to school. Parents, adults, sisters, grandparents etc are all welcome to join in!
- 4. **Disco -** The date for the postponed Disco will be determined and advertised within the next week.
