Good afternoon to all as we make our way through week 8 of the term.



The "Walk to Change the Story" event today was just outstanding in every way. The entire school joined the walk at GLCH centre at 10.30am and made our way down to the All Abilities Playground for a celebration. The mass of orange t-shirts signifies both the significant impact that violence has on our community and the growing force to address it. Sixty Three (63) women have been murdered by their current or past partner just this year and in a huge percentage of the cases, children have been present and directly impacted by this violence. Gender equality and respectful relationships are the key issues, that I am pleased to say, I think we are slowly turning in the right direction. I was very proud of all of our children and families today. Well done!

Tonight all the classes for 2019 will be created by staff and we will be taking into consideration the written information that I have received from parents. The teachers will be allocated to classes during next week.



The transition program for all children at all grade levels will continue to "tick along" and then "Roll up day and Orientation day" is on the 11^{th} of December. Please be encouraged to talk to your children about next year, what they are looking forward to and what they might be worried about. Open communication is vital to airing and clearing up any concerns.

As we work our way toward the end of the term, please be sure to keep everything at home calm and on track, as we will be doing the same here at school. This routine and structure sets each day up for maximum success.

Senior School Bowls and Croquet Program:

On Fridays our grade five and six students will begin working on a Bowls and Croquet development program during their Friday Afternoon Sports time.
